

Canon-McMillan School District Delayed Schedule Questions & Answers (8-10-2018)

Questions have been generated in regards to the delayed start date for the new school year. See below for a listing of those questions and the corresponding responses.

- 1) Will students who attend parochial schools start on time and will they receive transportation from the Canon-McMillan School District?** Yes. All parochial school students will receive transportation per their respective school schedules.
- 2) Will there be a revision to the School Calendar?** Yes. The Board of School Directors approved a revised School Calendar at their public meeting on August 9, 2018, which reflects a school start date of September 4, 2018. Should it be necessary to further delay the start date, the School Calendar will be revised accordingly.
- 3) Will the June 6th Graduation date remain in effect?** If school begins on September 4th, this date will not change. A later graduation date may be determined should the start date occur later than September 4th.
- 4) What is the source of the delay?** The scheduled start date of school was delayed due to the current high school expansion/renovation project. Specifically, areas including the cafeteria and classrooms are not expected to be ready for student occupancy until at least one to two weeks from the originally scheduled August 27th start date.
- 5) Why is all of the school district (K-12) being delayed if the issue lies with the high school construction project?** This decision was based on considering all of the variables related to operational and employee group contractual items.
- 6) Will transportation be provided for students who attend the Western Area Career & Technology Center (Vo-Tech)?** Bus transportation is not provided to students when the Canon-McMillan School district is not in session. If the Vo-Tech is in session when Canon-McMillan is not, students must make their own arrangements to attend. During the delay schedule, driving privileges will be granted should students choose to drive their own vehicles to the Vo-Tech. Once Canon-McMillan is back in session, students will be required to ride the bus, unless the student participates in a co-op program and approval is granted by the high school principal.
- 7) Will transportation occur for student athletes who participate in away events during the delay schedule?** Yes. Students are expected to arrive at the established location where they will be bussed to/from such events.
- 8) Will the Canon-McMillan School District provide childcare services while school buildings are vacant?** Childcare services are not provided by the school district.
