BEHAVIOR SUPPORT</p> <p>The Board, while keeping in compliance with state and federal regulations, shall establish behavior support practices for all eligible students.</p> <p>A behavioral support plan, in context of the revised regulations and standards, is a special education service for eligible students whose behavior problems interfere with learning. The regulations indicated that positive approaches that are less intrusive should be attempted in order to maintain and support the dignity of the individual student and teacher.</p> <p>The district shall develop procedures and intervention practices based upon state approved policy and practices. The interventions are predicated upon a clear and direct form of communication which is reasonable for all schools.</p>
