Dear Canon-McMillan Parents/Guardians:

The Canon-McMillan School District is dedicated to having a constant focus on safety and security in our buildings and facilities. As a result of a review of our safety and security plans for our C-M stadium activities, the following procedures for the health, safety, and welfare of all of our spectators will be implemented immediately.

- No containers of any type are permitted to be brought into the stadium. This includes but is not limited to coolers, thermos type containers, water/soda bottles, flasks or any other container that could be used to conceal an illegal beverage. Items that fall into the contraband category will be confiscated and disposed of at the gate by law enforcement officials.
- All bags may be searched for contraband items that are not permitted on school grounds. Items that fall into the contraband category will be confiscated and disposed of at the gate by law enforcement officials.
- All students in grades K-8 who wish to attend any home event at the stadium must be accompanied by an adult while on school property at all times. Students in grades K-8 who are not under the supervision of an adult will be denied admission and asked to leave the premises. The liability of having our younger students unsupervised by their parent/guardian is a true safety concern for the district.
- The school district will act according to district policies and procedures with regard to any individual who enters the stadium under the influence of an illegal substance or who is visibly intoxicated. The students will be subjected to disciplinary consequences and notification of the authorities. Situations involving adults will be handled by local law enforcement officials. There will be no exceptions.

We apologize for any inconvenience that this may cause, but to ensure the health, safety, and welfare of all of our spectators it is imperative that we enact these procedures at this time. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter; it is greatly appreciated.
